INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY CONTROLLED SCHOOLS


1. The name of the school is **Blakesley Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is “**The governing body of Blakesley Church of England Primary School** “
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) The Headteacher
 - (b) **2** parent governors elected
 - (c) **1** LA governor
 - (d) **1** staff governor elected
 - (e) **3** co-opted governors
 - (f) **2** foundation governors
5. Total number of governors is **10**
6. Foundation Governors are appointed by Peterborough Diocese Board of Education.
7. The school has an external Trust, The Foxley Trust.
8. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England, which includes respecting other faiths and in partnership with the Church in the parish of St Mary Blakesley and at diocesan level.

The school aims to serve the community of Blakesley by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

Blakesley CE Primary School is proud to be a Church of England School where every child and adult matters. We provide a happy, caring environment, based on our Christian values. We recognise that we are all created unique individuals; we support, value and celebrate these differences. We are committed to a high quality education which develops the potential of all.
