The process has begun for entry into reception at primary schools from the start of the new academic year in September 2023. The application portal is now live for parents/carers to submit their school preferences at www.westnorthants.gov.uk/admissions.

Parents/guardians are encouraged to apply online and read the online prospectus - Applying for a Primary School Place in West Northamptonshire 2023-24. This provides detailed information on schools and the application process.

If you know of anybody who is likely to be seeking a place for their child, please ask them to consider applying to our school. Open mornings for prospective parents are being held here, at Blakesley CE, on Thursday 13th October 2022, from 9.15am – 10.45am and on Wednesday 9th November 2022, from 9.15am – 10.45am. Please share the attached flyer, promoting our school, with as many people as you can. Thank you.

Parents have until 15 January 2023 to apply, with online applicants being notified by email on the national offer day – 17 April 2023. Paper applicants will be informed by letter, which will be posted out on offer day. Any application forms received by School Admissions after 15 January will be considered as late and will not be considered until May 2023 onwards.

Applying for a Year 7 secondary school place

If you are a parent or carer of a Y6 child in primary school living in West Northamptonshire applications can now be made for a secondary school place. You should apply for a place at a secondary school if your child has their 11th birthday between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023.

The closing date is 31st October 2022. After this deadline, a late application will need to be made.
