Safeguarding

Secondary Admissions: School places for Year 7 pupils in 2023

Please note there are key dates and deadlines for parents of current Year 6 pupils applying for Secondary School places for September 2023. All Towcester area (including Blakesley) schools fall under West Northants Council admissions. Please ensure that West Northants is selected when making an application.

The West Northants Council portal is open for applications. Applications close at 5pm on 31st October 2021. Failure to submit an application by the deadline may result in an application being treated as a late applicant and only allocated a place once all first round applicants' places have been filled. Please do not leave any applications to the last minute.
