#### Road safety awareness

Yesterday, all the pupils from Y3 to Y6 experienced some road safety awareness training with a difference as an HGV cab from the hardware company, Wickes, was driven onto the school playground. Safety officers led the sessions which provided the children with knowledge and understanding of the dangers for pedestrians and cyclists around an HGV. Blind spots were investigated as well as learning the names of certain parts. Seeing an HGV cab up so close, certainly gave a realisation of the size of such vehicles. Even though there were serious messages from the activity, climbing into the cab and getting behind the steering wheel was still fun for all.
