Further information regarding clubs

Art Club will be a club that will be a mix of teaching new skills or a chance to be creative. There is no cost. For Term 3 the club is available to any pupil in Class 3 or 4. For any child interested in attending please e mail Mr Hill on L.Hill@blakesley.pdet.org.uk Please note in Term 4 this club will then become available to all Class 2 children.

Nurture Natter club is a club that is open to all children and operates as a 'drop-in' centre. All children are welcome. Children have an opportunity to just talk, have a quiet time, read or say how they would like to occupy their time.

Safeguarding: Child Criminal Exploitation

Please see attached to this newsletter information that the local Police have asked us to share about Child Criminal Exploitation. Child Criminal Exploitation (CCE) is a type of child abuse. It occurs where an individual or group takes advantage of an imbalance of power to coerce, control, manipulate or deceive a child or young person under the age of 18 into any criminal activity. Whilst this is not necessarily information to share with your children it is information worth knowing and being aware of.
