

Dear Parents and Carers,



The start of term has been far from 'flat' as the whole school, on Tuesday, participated in Pancake races organised by our Year 6 pupils. Great fun was had by all as the children raced in their house teams flipping pancakes. Once all the results were collated Kingston House (yellows) won the event.

Pancake Day marks the Christian day known as Shrove Tuesday. Our assembly on this day was led by Leah Peters from the Lighthouse Trust. She explained how Shrove Tuesday is the start of the Easter season as the date marks the eve of Lent. Lent is the fasting period which commemorates the 40 days of fasting Jesus underwent in the desert before Easter, as written in the Bible.



Blakesley Book Day

For our part of celebrating World Book Day, we will be hosting 'Blakesley Book Day' on Thursday 9th March. Our theme for the day is 'Traditional Tales'. We invite all our pupils to dress up, as part of our theme or if they prefer, they may dress up as their favourite character or as any character from a book of their choice. Groupchats on mobile phones/devices

Occurring through messaging apps, on social media and in online games, group chats are among the most popular ways that young children engage with their peers online. Involving, by definition, three or more individuals, these groups allow users to send messages, images and videos to everyone in one place. While they are useful for helping friends, people with shared interests or members of a club to communicate and coordinate activities, they can also leave young people feeling excluded and bullied – as well as providing opportunities for inappropriate content to be shared and viewed.

Attached is a guide that offers tips on several potential risks such as bullying, inappropriate content and unknown members.

We urge all parents to regularly monitor their child's use of a mobile phone/device.
